The Indian Space Research Organization is the national space agency of India, headquartered in Bangalore. ISRO is India's primary agency for performing tasks related to space-based applications, space exploration and the development of related technologies. It is one of six government space agencies in the world which possess full launch capabilities, deploy cryogenic engines, launch extra-terrestrial missions and operate large fleets of artificial satellites.



ISRO built India's first satellite, Aryabhata, which was launched by the Soviet Union in 1975. In 1980, ISRO launched satellite RS-1 onboard its own SLV-3, making India the seventh country to be capable of undertaking orbital launches. SLV-3 was followed by ASLV, which was subsequently succeeded by development of many medium-lift launch vehicles, rocket engines, satellite systems and networks enabling the agency to launch hundreds of domestic and foreign satellites and various deep space missions for space exploration.

ISRO has the world's largest constellation of remote-sensing satellites and operates the GAGAN and NAVIC satellite navigation systems. It has sent two missions to the Moon and one to Mars.

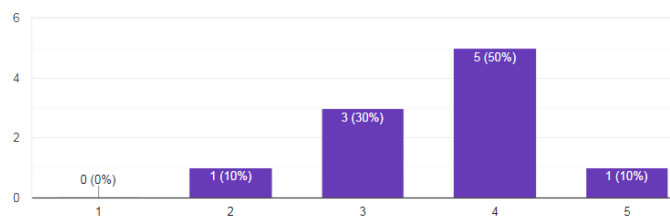

Introduction

This report provides an overview of the 36-hour hackathon that took place at City Engineering College, located in Doddakalsandra, Kanakapura Road, Bengaluru. The event, which occurred on December 20th and 21st, 2022, aimed to bring together Creative Minds from diverse backgrounds and provide them with an opportunity to Develop Innovative Solutions to a Specific Problem or Challenge.

The Hackathon, which was organized by the College, attracted participants from all semesters of our college, and the event was designed to foster Collaboration and Ideation among participants, providing them with a platform to showcase their Creativity and Innovation. To ensure maximum participation, the hackathon was organized as a Hybrid Event, allowing participants to attend both Offline and Online, regardless of their geographical location. The Hackathon lasted for 36 hours, providing participants with ample time to work on their Projects and Develop Innovative Solutions.

Event Mode and Duration

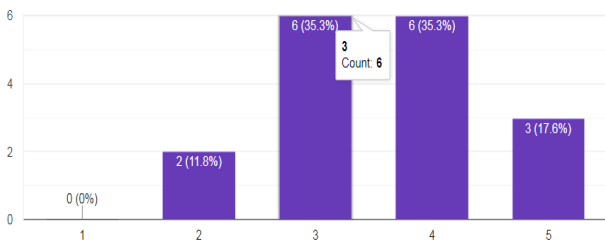

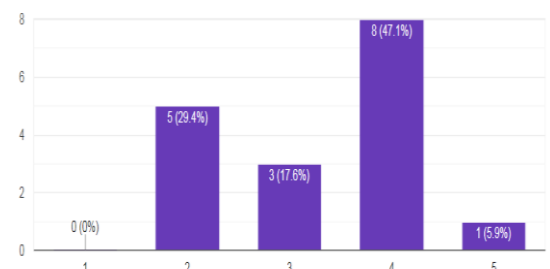

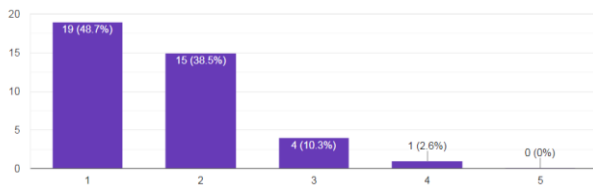

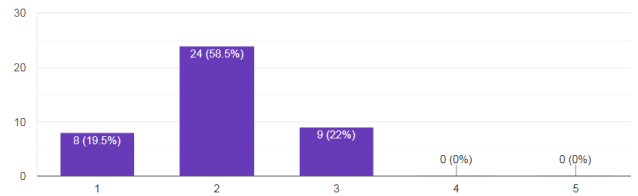

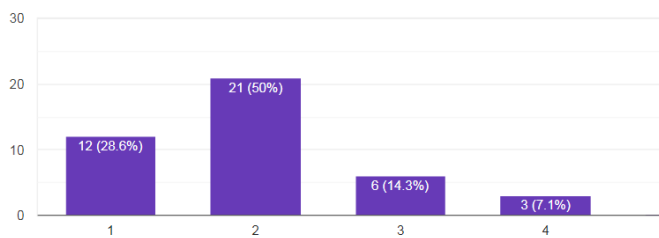

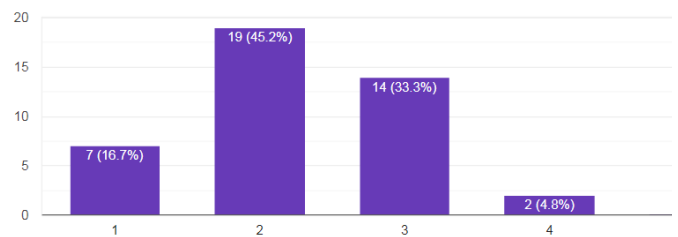
