

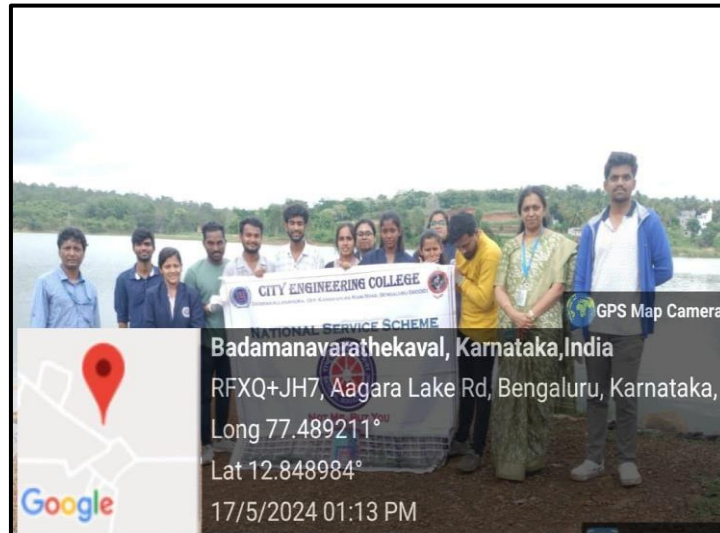


Fig1. Students and faculty participated in a lake cleaning initiative at Agara Lake



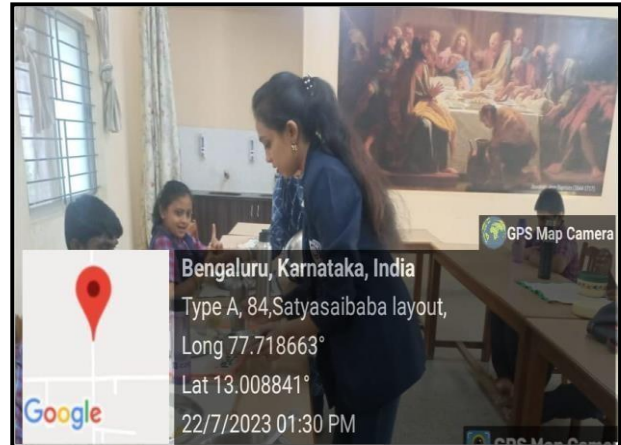


Fig 2. CEC Students serving food to children

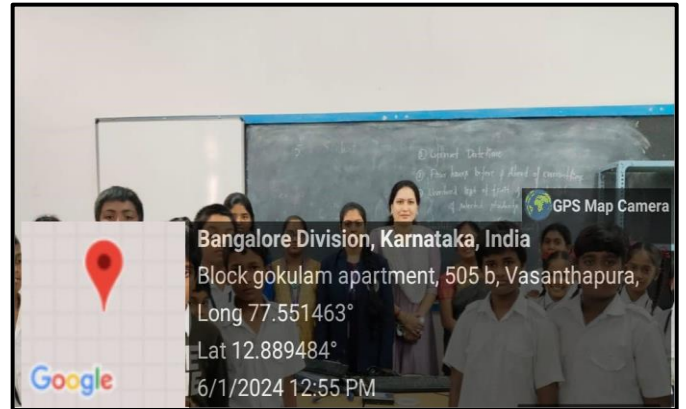


Fig2. Dr. Sowmya, HOD, Dept. of CSE, explained the importance of computers
