#### POLICY TITLE:

Free ships to students.

#### POLICY STATEMENT:

In an effort to recognize and encourage academic excellence, City Engineering College annually awards students falling under these categories:

Aimed at supporting economically weaker students, the College provides need-based Free ships during admission and every semester to enable them to overcome financial constraints to continue higher education.

#### POLICY PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE:

Free ships are given by way of financial aid and complete exemption of Tuition Fee during admission and every semester to provide equal opportunity to students from economically marginalized section to continue higher education.

#### FEATURES OF THE POLICY:

Funded by: Jayanagar Education Society, Special Funds created by individuals associated with the College.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- Free ships: Annual income of parents and other criteria as decided by the Staff Council constituted Fee Concession Committee from time to time.

**APPLICATION:**

- Free ships: Eligible students are required to apply in each semester in the prescribed format along with the required documents.

**SELECTION PROCESS:**

**The details are given below:**

Our honorable Chairman Dr. K R Paramahamsa by supporting with financial assistance through scholarship for the economically weaker students for the academic year 2020-21.

1. **Free ships:** The applications are invited and received from students. They are scrutinized by the Fee concession committee along with the authenticity of the documents. The shortlisted students are called by the committee heads for the interaction with the Committee members on a prior determined date. The Committee finalizes the students list based on assessment of the need of the students and for the free ships available. In certain cases, students are granted partial free ships.

**PROCESS AND PROCEDURE:**

The College issues notification inviting application from students across disciplines on the prescribed format along with all the required supporting document.

### List of Documents:

1	School Leaving Certificate (Class X)
2	High School Leaving Certificate (Class XII)
3	Result of previous academic semester (if applicable)
4	Family annual income certificate
5	Aadhaar card Bank Passbook
6	BPL Ration Card
7	Fee receipt of current semester Self - declaration of parents/students
8	Any Deceased Parent (Death Certificate)

1. The Committee scrutinizes the applications received, along with the authenticity of the documents.
2. The shortlisted students are called for an interaction with the Committee members on a prior date. They must carry all the documents in original.
3. The Committee finalizes the students list based on assessment of the need of the students and the number of free ships available.
