AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

City Engineering College believes in acknowledging and appreciating the achievements of its students. We honor our outstanding students for their hard work and sincerity thorough awards and scholarships.

POLICY TITLE:

Award of Academic Prizes, Merit Scholarships and Free ships to students.

POLICY STATEMENT:

In an effort to recognize and encourage academic excellence, City Engineering College annually awards students falling under these three categories:

- 1. Academic Prizes/Merit Scholarships for academically meritorious students.
- Aimed at supporting economically weaker students, the College provides need-based Free ships during admission and every semester to enable them to overcome financial constraints to continue higher education.
- CECAA assists Alumni Scholarship which are provided annually by CECAA on needcum-merit basis.

POLICY PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE:

- Academic Prizes/ Merit Scholarships are given by way of grant to felicitate students for achieving outstanding results in the University examinations.
- Free ships are given by way of financial aid and complete exemption of Tuition Fee during admission and every semester to provide equal opportunity to students from economically marginalized section to continue higher education.
- CECAA also carries/ conducts Corporate Social Responsibility have been instituted to
 encourage the Alumni to get connected with their alma mater and be a significant part of
 the corporate life of the College.

FEATURES OF THE POLICY:

Funded by: Jayanagar Education Society, Special Funds created by individuals associated with the College and the City Engineering College Alumni Association (CECAA) of the College.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Academic prizes/Merit Scholarships: First, Second and Third positions in each course/programme offered by the College based on annual academic results and fulfilling the respective criteria for each special scholarship instituted.
- Free ships: Annual income of parents and other criteria as decided by the Staff Council constituted Fee Concession Committee from time to time.
- Alumni Scholarship: Need-cum-merit basis.
- The Academic prizes, Merit Scholarships and Alumni Scholarship are validated by the Staff Council constituted Prizes and Scholarship Committee.

APPLICATION:

- Academic prizes/Scholarships: The Prizes and Scholarship Committee annually scrutinizes
 results of students of each course/programme offered by the College in the University
 examinations.
- Free ships: Eligible students are required to apply in each semester in the prescribed format along with the required documents.
- City Engineering College Alumni Association Scholarship: Academic performance toppers are honored by CECAA for first-year BE students in each cycle receives a scholarship with amount.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Academic Prizes/ scholarships: The Prizes and Scholarship Committee selects students
with First, Second and Third positions in each course, based on highest marks obtained in
university examinations, for Academic Prizes'. The Committee selects students for each
Scholarship, based on the below mentioned criteria.

The College has introduced the **Kalluri Manikyam Awards** in memory of **Kalluri Manikyam**, mother of K R Paramahamsa. Our honorable Chairman Dr. K R Paramahamsa by supporting with financial assistance through scholarship for meritorious students for the academic year 2023-24.

Kalluri Manikyam Award, which includes a memento, a certificate and cash prize of

- Rs 3000/- will be given to the student who has secured highest aggregate percentage in all semesters (from among all the courses taken together).
- Rs.2000/- per year will be awarded as to the student who has secured the Second highest marks (from among all the courses taken together).
- Rs.1000/- per year will be awarded to the student who has secured the Third highest marks (from among all the courses taken together).
- 2. Free ships: The applications are invited and received from students. They are scrutinized by the Fee concession committee along with the authenticity of the documents. The shortlisted students are called by the committee heads for the interaction with the Committee members on a prior determined date. The Committee finalizes the students list based on assessment of the need of the students and for the free ships available. In certain cases, students are granted partial free ships.
- CECAA: The scholarship are scrutinized by the Head of the Department, scholarship
 committee and a topper of physics/ Chemistry cycle for BE areapproved annually by the
 CECAA.

PROCESS AND PROCEDURE:

ACADEMIC PRIZES/MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS AND ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIPS

- The Prizes and Scholarship Committee annually scrutinizes results of students of each course/programme offered by the College in the University examinations to select First, Second and Third positions from each course/program me for academic prizes and for Merit Scholarships.
- 2. For Prizes/Merit Scholarships and Alumni Scholarships, the selected students are informed.
- Cash prize and certificate is awarded every year, preferably on the College Day function
 of the College.

4. The College issues notification inviting application from students across disciplines on the prescribed format along with all the required supporting document.

Any Deceased Parent (Death Certificate)

- 5. The Committee scrutinizes the applications received, along with the authenticity of the documents.
- 6. The shortlisted students are called for an interaction with the Committee members on a prior date. They must carry all the documents in original.
- 7. The Committee finalizes the students list based on assessment of the need of the students and the number of free ships available.
