#### **Introduction:**




Fig 1: Student	T.4.1	. D 1	Conton




Fig 2: Student audit data based on Gender




Fig 3: Student Intake- Category Wise matrix for Boys




Fig 6: Student intake Audit data based on category for Girls





Fig 8: Fa	culty Audit data


#### Objectives

- 5. **Develop Recommendations**: Propose actionable recommendations for policymakers, educators, and stakeholders to address identified disparities and barriers and to enhance gender equity in the Indian education system.








Fig 15: Anti Ragging Awareness programme




Fig 19: Handbook on Sexual harassment procedure followed in City

Engineering college given by Govt of Karnataka




Fig 20: Key points to be noted during Complaint content




Fig 21: Sexual harassment Complaint Process






Fig 29: Fire Extinguishing equipment's in the campus
