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#### Day wise Report:

### Day 1: Obtaining Authorization from the Panchayat Office

The students initiated the project by obtaining the necessary permissions from the local Panchayat office. This step ensured that their activities were authorized and supported by the local governing body.

#### Day 2: Project Area Survey and Assessment

A thorough survey of the designated project area was conducted. This involved assessing the extent of garbage accumulation, identifying key areas that needed immediate attention, and planning the logistics of the clean-up operation.

#### Day 3: Garbage Collection and Cleaning Drive

The students actively participated in collecting and cleaning the garbage. They focused on both solid waste and plastic waste, ensuring that the area was cleared of all types of litter.

#### Day 4: Community Awareness Campaign

To ensure long-term success and sustainability, the students conducted awareness campaigns. They educated the local community on the importance of proper garbage disposal, the benefits of maintaining a clean environment, and practical ways to manage waste effectively.

#### Day 5: Organic Waste Collection and Composting

Organic waste was segregated from other types of waste. The students set up composting facilities to process this organic waste, turning it into useful compost that can be used to enrich the soil.

#### Day 6: Controlled Combustion of Solid Organic Waste

Solid organic waste that could not be composted was subjected to controlled combustion. This process helped in reducing the volume of waste and managing it in an environmentally friendly manner.

#### Day 7: Project Outcome and Certification from Panchayat Office

Upon the successful completion of the project, the students documented the outcomes, highlighting the improvements in the cleanliness and hygiene of the area. They then approached the Panchayat office to obtain a letter of completion, which served as official recognition of their efforts and achievements.

#### **Outcome:**

Around 200 people of Arakere are helped through this extension activity.




Fig2. Students involved in Lake cleanliness drive

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




Fig1&2. Students Distributing Paper Bags made from old Newspapers
